INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

The **Department of Economics** in collaboration with the **Departments of Chemical Engineering** and **Mathematics** of the **University of Western Macedonia** invites high school graduates wishing to pursue a Bachelor of Science (**B.Sc.**) degree in **Economics and Sustainable Development** to apply for admission to the program. The deadline for applications is **23 June 2025**.

The bachelor's in **Economics and Sustainable Development** is a four-year, eight-semester program with a three-month optional practical placement, awarding a B.Sc. degree with a total of 240 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) credits (243 with the optional practical placement). Courses take place at the Campus facilities of the University of Western Macedonia in Kastoria.

Students enrolled in the program are granted a certificate for their registration, which they must present to the Greek consular authorities of their country to obtain a Visa for studies (type D Visa). Upon arrival residence permit must be obtained for the duration of 4.5 years (including 6 months for the optional practical placement). The annual tuition fees are 4,000 euros payable in two equal installments, paid two weeks before the start of each semester, each.

Eligible candidates are holders of a high school diploma or a corresponding to level 3 education certificate according to the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED). Applicants and either of their parents must not have Greek citizenship or nationality.

Candidates must submit the following documents/certificates:

- 1. Photocopy of passport or national identity card.
- 2. Document proving the address of the candidate's permanent residence

3. High school diploma or equivalent to level 3 education certificate according to the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED). For final-year students, a transcript of the courses and grades obtained so far is required (in this case a provisional offer of admission may be made).

4. The Admissions Committee of the program may request, on a case-by-case basis, proof of the

candidate's ability to cover the cost of studies and stay in Kastoria. Also, it may request any additional supporting documents, that it deems necessary for the formulation of the judgment decision on the candidate's application.
